Is he lazy this morning?

We are running to catch the bus right now. – PRESENT CONTINUOUS

We aren't running to catch the bus right now.
Are you running to catch the bus right now?

We went to the cinema at the weekend. – PAST SIMPLE

We didn't go to the cinema at the weekend.
Did you go to the cinema at the weekend?

I was sleeping when he left. – PAST CONTINUOUS

I wasn't sleeping when he left.
Were you sleeping when he left?

She has already started smoking at 15! – PRESENT PERFECT

She hasn't started smoking yet.
Has she started smoking yet?

You had already sent the email when you heard the news. – PAST PERFECT

You hadn't sent the email yet when you heard the news.
Had you already sent the email when you heard the news?

*My boss has been waiting for this email for two weeks now. – PRESENT PERFECT
CONTINUOUS*

My boss hasn't been waiting for this email for two weeks.
Has my boss been waiting for this email for two weeks?

My sister is going to get married soon. – FUTURE with GOING TO

My sister isn't going to get married soon.
Is my sister going to get married soon?

I will help him carry the heavy bags! – FUTURE with WILL

I won't help him carry the heavy bags.
Will you help him carry the heavy bags?

*My kids will have finished their homework by the time I get home. – FUTURE IN THE
PAST*

My kids won't have finished their homework by the time I get home.
Will my kids have finished their homework by the time I get home?

This bridge was built by the former mayor. – THE PASSIVE VOICE- PAST SIMPLE

This bridge wasn't built by the FORMER MAYOR.
Was this bridge built by the former mayor?
